(1) - 80cm: silty sand

BARREL SHEET SUMMARY

* MUD with abundant anhydrite clusters and crystals all down the section.

* 81-88cm: clast 7cm long, subrounded of silicified mudclast breccia - ORIGIN open to speculation. * possible hydraulic breccia
97cm onwards: sulphide is patchily distributed in irregular clumps = fine grained pyrite. Less than 2%.

118-140cm: Peculiar orange-red staining

Smear slide

Matches the usual grey / white colour of the section.
← Possible Fe alteration?
Not just a surface effect + continues into next section.
