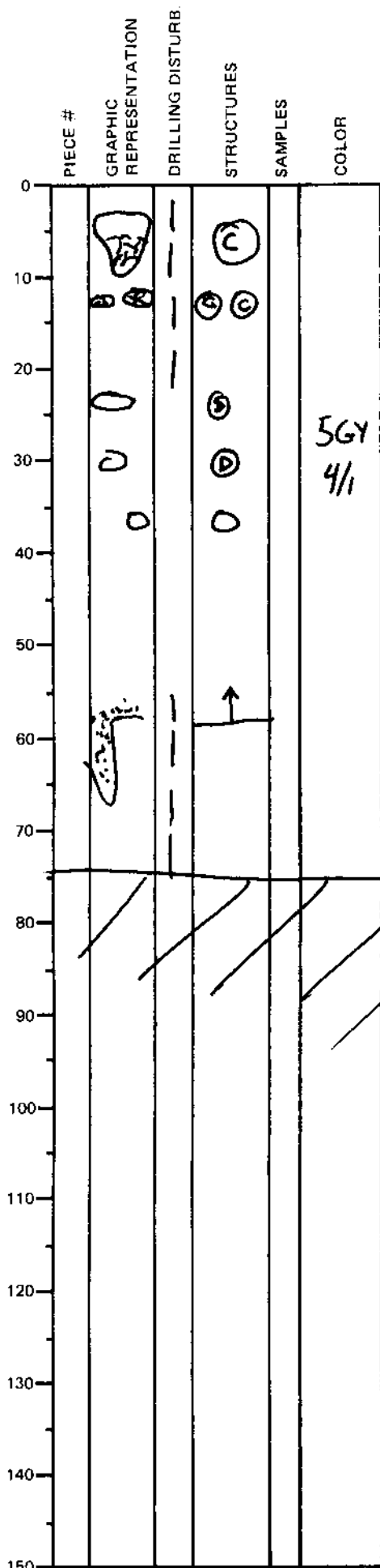

dark grayish gray (5GY4/1)  
weakly indurated  
silty clay

fine sand turbidite, fining  
upward; dismembered somewhat  
by coring at ~57-60cm

Several nodules.

-the large nodule of calcite  
at 4-10 cm (and the  
bits of nodule at 12cm)  
are distinctive and the  
same as seen at  
this level in the  
B hole. The nodule is  
cracked with anastomosing  
vein fill of calcite  
including brown calcite  
enclaves in voids

-smaller dolomite (?) nodules  
occur at 24, 30, 36 cm
