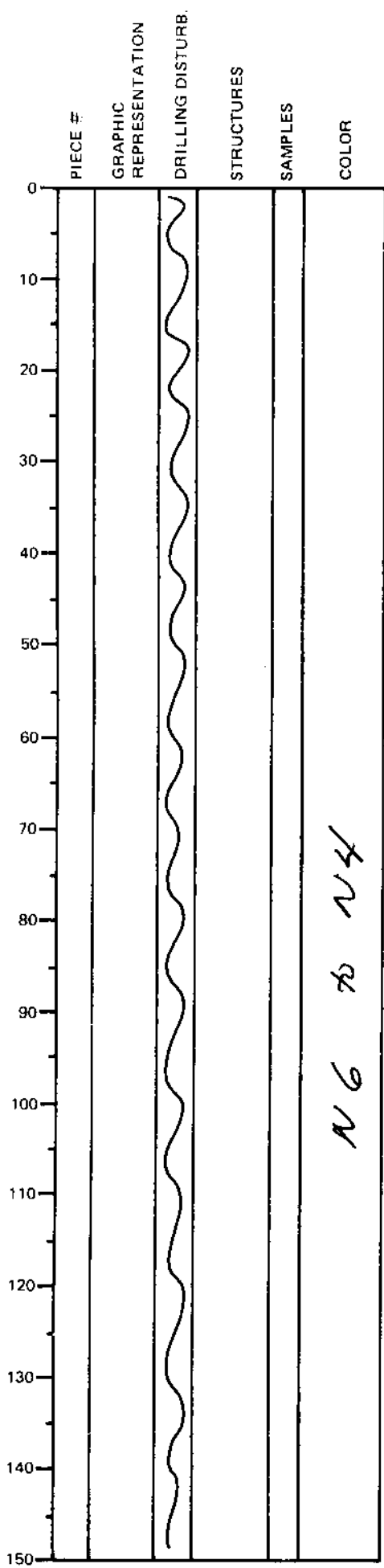

Very disturbed -- basically drill "cuttings" -- gray to dark gray (N4 to N6), sand- to gravel-size chunks of SILTY CLAY & VERY FINE SAND (as in section 1 of this core).

A few large (up to 4 cm) pieces of sulfide-rich sandstone, silty claystone are present, as well as several pieces massive sulfide. This is assumed to be all "fall-in," but it may (along with the rest of this zone) be the crushed remains of a sulfide-impregnated brecciated sediment.
