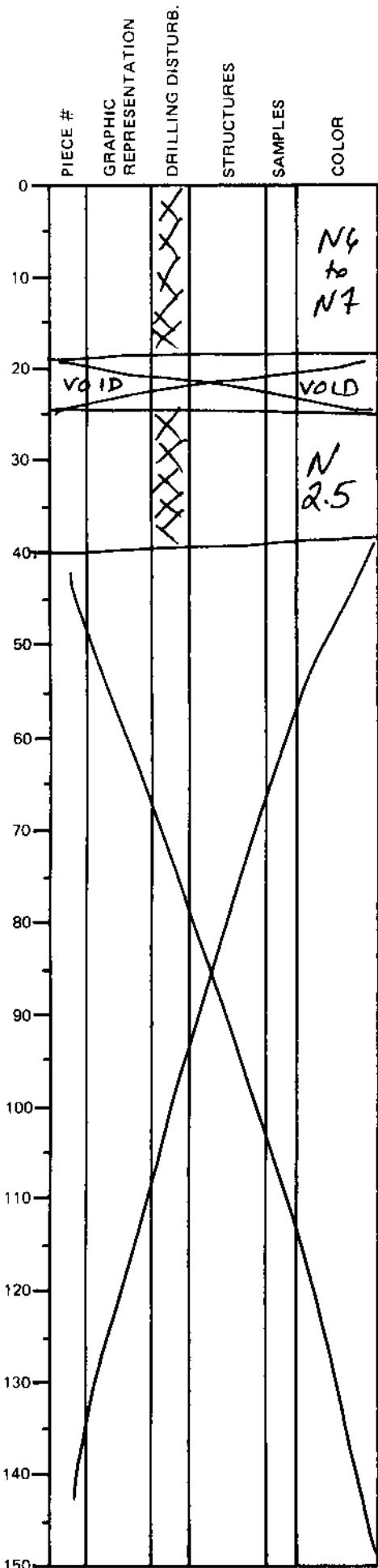

0-16 cm

Gray (N6) to light gray (N7) drilling-rubble (possibly in place?) of SILTY CLAYSTONE (N7) and CLAYSTONE N(6).

24-38 cm

BASALT, black, fine-grained (rubbed)

fresh, microphyric basalt with plagioclase phenocrysts. Fine chilled margin at top with vesicles filled with quartz and probably green chlorite lining the vesicles. Thin vein with euhedral pyrite. Bleached and chloritized selvages.
